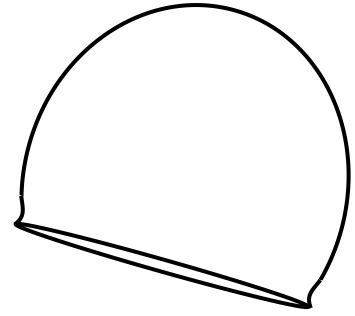


# Fibers

## Chinchilla Chemo Cap



**Materials:** 1 ball Berroco Chinchilla

**Needles:** Size US 8 AND 9 circular, 16 OR 20"

AND Size US 9 DP

10 Stitch markers (for the needle); One should be distinctive.

**Gauge:** 3 sts = 1"

### Abbreviations:

CO = Cast On

St = stitch

Rnd = round

PM = Place Marker

K2tog = Knit 2 together by inserting your needle into the second st, then into the first and knitting them as if they were one stitch

### To make Cap:

With Double pointed needles, CO 5 sts. Join for knitting in the round, without twisting sts. Distribute the stitches comfortably around the needles, and change to circulars (US 9) when you can.

Work 6 increase rounds as follows. After each increase round, work one round even.

Inc.Rnd 1: Inc 1 st in every st (10 sts)

Inc Rnd 2: Inc 1 st in every st (20 sts)

Inc Rnd 3 : \*Inc 1 in next st, K1, PM. Repeat from \* around (30 sts) Use your distinctive marker to mark the END of the round.

Inc Rnd 4: \*Inc 1, K to marker. Repeat from \* around (40 sts)

Inc Rnd 5: \*Inc 1, K to marker. Repeat from \* around (50 sts)

Inc Rnd 6: \*Inc 1, K to marker. Repeat from \* around (60 sts)

Continue knitting every round until piece measure about 8 - 8.5" from beginning.

Next round: With your left hand needle, and working from back to front, pick up the running thread between the last stitch and the first st.

Leave it on the needle and turn your work so that the wrong side is now facing you, and you are working backwards, rather than continuing around with the right side facing you.

Knit around until you have 1 st and the lifted st left. Knit them together. (This allows you to turn the work and knit backwards without leaving a hole in your work!)

Change to smaller circular needles.

Next rnd: \*K to 2 sts before marker, K2tog. Repeat from \* around. (54 sts)

Continue knitting every round for 1.5"

Bind off loosely.
